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COVID-19 UBC BREB and UBC Okanagan Chairs' Bulletin #1

Dear UBC Researchers and Staff,

In addition to information you have been receiving from the University of British Columbia, we would like to inform you of the following:

- All research activities and new recruitment of participants to research that involve inperson interactions should **be suspended until further notice** (exceptions may be made in special situations, such as research involving COVID-19 or where stopping the research could put participants at risk. Please contact the BREB if you think your research fits into this exception).
- If you need to make immediate changes to your research methods, e.g. changing an in person interview to a skype interview, and will not have time to submit an amendment before engaging with participants, you may make the changes without REB approval when the change is **necessary to eliminate an immediate risk to participants** [TCPS2 Article 6.15]. You will temporarily be granted a maximum window of 10 days to submit the amendment to the BREB.
- The BREB will **continue to review** new research applications and work with PIs to bring them to a state of readiness for approval.
- No new studies involving **in-person interaction** with participants will receive a Certificate of Approval and recruitment may **not** begin until further notice (exceptions may be made in special situations, such as research involving COVID-19)
- New studies that **do not involve in-person** interaction with participants and do not pose any risks to researchers or research staff will be reviewed using standard procedures and research can begin once a certificate of approval is received.

 We ask that any New Studies, Post Approval Activities (PAAs) or e-mails sent to to the REB that relate to issues or queries relating to COVID-19 are named accordingly so that they can be easily tracked. In RISe, for adjustments to your study, please nickname your amendment "COVID-19 Related Protocol Changes." For new research about COVID-19, please nickname your new RISe research application or amendment "COVID-19 Research."

Please be aware that, as the current situation is very fluid, these interim policies may well change, and we will update you as necessary in future bulletins.
